Online Applications Now Available

The Department of Consumer Protection ("Department") is pleased to announce that online applications are available and live for all liquor permit types, effective October 23, 2023. This includes on-premises, off-premises, manufacturer, and wholesaler permits. Paper applications will be accepted through January 1, 2024. After that date, only online applications will be accepted.

Please note that local official signatures are still required for all applications. New forms have been created for applicants to obtain those signatures. The applications link to the new form, and our website has the forms in fillable PDF form. The form must be uploaded as part of the online application.
