# **Health Information Exchange**

Health Information Exchange allows health care professionals and patients to appropriately access and securely share a patient's medical information electronically.

Sharing electronic patient information enables providers to:

- Access and confidentially share patients' vital medical history, no matter where patients are receiving care—specialists' offices, labs, or emergency rooms
- Provide safer, more effective care tailored to patients' unique medical needs

Independent, not-for-profit, neutral and trusted organization authorized by State statute (CGS 17b-59d and 17b-59g) to develop and operate statewide HIE in Connecticut.



- InContext App: SMART on FHIR embedded app for EMRs (Epic, Cerner, eCW, Athena)





# **Encounter Notification**

- Real-time worklist to help manage patients as they transition among health care settings
- Available as data feed
- Smart alerts (to be implemented)
  - Worklists developed based on lab results, discharge dx, risk scores, demographics, etc.






#### **Image Exchange**

# Possible School Setting Use Cases

**School absenteeism** - School Absenteeism has been shown to correlate with general health and well being of a student. Pediatricians have expressed interest in knowing whether their patients have experienced high rates of absenteeism.

**Managing Asthma in School** – Supporting the sharing of asthma care plans between pediatricians and school-based providers





#### **How does Connie Protect Patient Data?**

- 1. Apply Federal and State Laws
- 2. Ensure controlled access
- Apply Best in Breed Privacy and Security Standards
- 4. Listen to Stakeholders
- 5. Implement Policies and Procedures





# **Only Authorized Users Have Access**

Careful records are kept on any health information accessed through **Connie**.

#### Authorized Users are associated with an organization that has:

- a legally binding data sharing agreement with Connie that identifies the extensive requirements for privacy, confidentiality and security of the information accessible through Connie.
- signed a Use Case Exhibit, which specifies the permitted purpose under which the data is shared/used.

#### Any user accessing health information through Connie must:

- have a specific reason to do so, such as providing treatment to the person whose health information they are accessing.
  - OR-
- The patient has consented through (a) their provider; or (b) through participating in a program that includes consent.





# **Consent and Privacy**

- Default consumer consent policy for the health information exchange is opt-out
- Consumer must proactively and explicitly opt out
  - Exceptions:
    - Sensitive health information including SUD Part 2 data
    - Requires affirmative consent
- Register opt-out decision at conniect.org/opt-out
  - One-time opt out for all providers
  - Can be revoked at any time







#### **Connie Statute**

- Within <u>one year</u> of commencement of operations, hospitals and labs shall apply to begin the process of connecting to and participating in the HIE
- Within two years of commencement of operations, any individual, corporation, facility or institution licensed by the state to provide health care services shall apply to begin the process of connecting to and participating in the HIE
  - Includes primary care and specialty physician practices, pharmacies, and SNFs

Submit Commit to Connect form to Connie through info@conniect.org.

Submitting this form kicks off the connection process and assigns an account manager to your organization.

## Let's make it official

Execute the legal documents.

Review and sign the necessary legal documents including the trusted data sharing agreement and applicable use case exhibits.

### Let's discuss data

Determine what data you will contribute and/ or access based on your eligibility, data interests, and viewing preferences.

Work with your account manager and Connie's technical team to complete technical onboarding activities and training. (Approximately 2 months)

#### You're connected!

#### Share the news internally and externally.

Use the training guides and communications toolkit as resources to get your organization started and let stakeholders know your organization participates in the state-wide health information exchange.


