

**“Signs and Symptoms of Carbon Monoxide Poisoning and
What to do if You Suspect Carbon Monoxide Poisoning” Script**

30 seconds

Get out of the house and get medical help right away if you or a family member have signs of carbon monoxide poisoning. Signs include headache, fatigue, dizziness, nausea, vomiting or loss of consciousness. Call 9-1-1 from a cell phone outside of your home or from a neighbor’s home. Also call the Connecticut Poison Control Center at 1-800-222-1222. This is a message from the Connecticut Department of Public Health.
