A presentation was given by Michael Fedorczyk, DC, National Board of Chiropractic regarding the Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services (EBAS) essay exam that assesses an individual's understanding of ethics and boundaries in a professional setting. The licensee is presented with realistic, hypothetical scenarios and asked to submit an appropriate response. The licensee is required to identify the ethical violation, discuss consequences, identify solutions and explain how the unethical actions in the provided scenario compromise the community's safety and welfare.

Examinations concerning the following are offered:

- Boundary Violations
- Fraud
- Professional Standards
- Substance Abuse
- Unprofessional Conduct

Various States utilize EBAS to evaluate licensees who are subject to licensure discipline.
