IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. Marjorie Corker-Holzer, MD – Review of License Reinstatement Application
Celeste Dowdell, License and Applications Analyst, Department of Public Health presented a license reinstatement application for Marjorie Corker-Holzer, MD.
Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Mr. Kaliko, to recommend license reinstatement.
During discussion Dr. Green and Dr. Wolf spoke in opposition to the recommendation.
Dr. Green, Dr. Wolf, Dr. London, Mr. McAnaney; Dr. Yuan, Dr. Sauer, Mr. Andrews and Dr. Rissi voted to oppose the recommendation. Mr. Kaliko, Dr. Schwindt, Dr. Duffy; Dr. Kohlhepp; Ms. Rexford, Ms. Jacklin and Ms. Emmett voted in favor. The motion failed.
Dr. Kohlhepp made a motion, seconded by Mr. Kaliko, to recommend license reinstatement that included one year of supervised practice. During discussion Dr. Wolf made a motion, seconded by Dr. Green, to table this matter. The motion to table passed with all in favor except Ms. Jacklin and Ms. Rexford who were opposed.

V. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. Susannah Tung, MD; Petition No. 2020-386

Staff Attorney Linda Fazzina, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter.

Respondent and her attorney were not present

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wolf, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a reprimand and probation for a period of four years. The motion passed unanimously.
