

Request for Proposals (RFP) Log # 2024-0908 For Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias Training Programs for Healthcare Professionals and Community Professionals

RFP Summary. The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), Chronic Diseases Unit is seeking proposals from Connecticut public and private organizations and community-based agencies to provide training programs for the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias (ADRD) Program for medical professionals and community professionals. An anticipated total of approximately \$100,000 annually for a total of \$500,000 of federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) ADRD funds are available to support this project.

- Component 1: Training for Medical Professionals will be supported by \$50,000 annually for 5 funding periods and
- Component 2: Training for Community Professionals will be supported by \$50,000 annually for 5 funding periods.

Applicants may apply for one or both components of funding; however, if applying for both components, a separate scope of services and budget must be provided.

Funding will be for a 4.5-year period beginning approximately May 1, 2024, through September 29, 2028, subject to the availability of funds and satisfactory program performance. Proposals must be received by the official contact via email by **November 21, 2023 at 3 PM.**
