An RFA was conducted, and multiple sites have been awarded funding for medical, mental health, dental expansion or new sites. Funding will go through 6/30/2024. 10 million ARPA funding will be available to fund mental health expansion or new sites only, with a focus of locations identified in the PA 21-35 Sec. 16 workgroup report. DPH is in the process of conducting an RFP for a fiduciary to distribute this funding. Funding runs through 12/31/2024. 	
5. CASBHC Update	 CASBHC Conference November 7, 2023 at the Heritage Hotel in Southbury. Looking for a motivational speaker for the keynote. SBHC budget from Appropriations has an increase of approximately \$860,000 over 3 years.
