Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2015 Regular Session on June 19th.

HB 6724 AN ACT CONCERNING TECHNICAL AND MINOR REVISIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT
PA 15-51 OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES STATUTES.

PA 15-52 This bill shall take effect January 1, 2016.

This bill shall take effect July 1, 2015.

This bill shall take effect October 1, 2015.

This bill shall take effect from passage.

SB 975 AN ACT MAKING MINOR AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO DEPARTMENT OF
PA 15-60 CONSUMER PROTECTION STATUTES.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2015.

HB 5174 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CHILDREN'S STATE FLOWER.
PA 15-77 This bill shall take effect from passage.

HB 6366 AN ACT CONCERNING PROOF OF IDENTITY FOR A "DRIVE ONLY" MOTOR VEHICLE
PA 15-79 OPERATORS LICENSE.
This bill shall take effect from July 1, 2015.

HB 6738 AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PROGRAM REVIEW
PA 15-80 AND INVESTIGATIONS COMMITTEE CONCERNING THE FEDERAL ACHIEVING A
BETTER LIFE EXPERIENCE ACT.
This bill shall take effect from October 1, 2015.

PA 15-83 This bill shall take effect from October 1, 2015.

SB 1090 AN ACT CONCERNING GAMING.
SA 15-7 This bill shall take effect from passage.

SB 865 AN ACT CONCERNING ALLOWABLE COSTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN
PA 15-105 OVERSIZED WATER MAINS.
This bill shall take effect from passage.

SB 1078 AN ACT CONCERNING AFFORDABLE AND RELIABLE ENERGY.

As of this date, the Governor has signed eighty nine (89) bills and vetoed one (1) bill of the 2015 Legislative Session.
