Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2017 Regular Session on July 5:

- HB 7202 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DIVISION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION
PA 17-100 PROGRAMS WITHIN THE TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL SYSTEM.
This bill shall take effect from passage.
- HB 7311 AN ACT CONCERNING LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES AND BUSINESS
PA 17-108 CORPORATIONS.

- HB 6012 AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION IN EYE CARE.
PA 17-115 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

PA 17-119 CERTAIN ABUSE AND NEGLECT PROCEEDINGS.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.

PA 17-127 LEAVES OF ABSENCE FOR NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS, APPLICATION FOR

TO FEDERAL MILITARY LAW ENFORCEMENT.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7132 AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF NOTICE OF A CLAIM FOR
PA 17-141 COMPENSATION BY AN EMPLOYEE TO AN EMPLOYER OR A WORKERS'
COMPENSATION COMMISSIONER.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 444 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH CARE CABINET TO RECOMMEND
PA 17-151 METHODS TO STUDY AND REPORT ON TOTAL STATE-WIDE HEALTH CARE
SPENDING.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7073 AN ACT CONCERNING REMEDIES IN LAWSUITS AGAINST PROPERTY
PA 17-182 OWNERS BY SUBCONTRACTORS AND THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE
WITHHELD IN PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7156 AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO STUDENT RECORDS FOR CERTAIN
PA 17-194 UNACCOMPANIED YOUTHS.
This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 7176 AN ACT CREATING A MILITARY RECRUITMENT RIBBON.
PA 17-196 This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 6333 AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN AUTHORITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
PA 17-208 AGRICULTURE RELATING TO THE FOOD SAFETY MODERNIZATION ACT.
This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 7221 AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO WATER PLANNING INFORMATION.
PA 17-211 This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 7226 AN ACT CONCERNING AWARDS FROM THE CONNECTICUT ARTS
PA 17-213 ENDOWMENT FUND.
This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 7229 AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF CONNECTICUT BROWNFIELD LAND
PA 17-214 BANKS, REVISIONS TO THE BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION AND
REVITALIZATION PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR
BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS.
This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.

As of this date, the Governor has signed one hundred fifty-three (153) bills of the 2017 Legislative Session.
