Per Chair, hold on agenda for further investigation. OSBI to investigate and request more information. OSBI reached out to the Appellant and Building Official and recommends moving forward. - A-23-04 RE: Request for Appeal received 3/3/23 from Paul Payne, New Canaan Fire Marshal RE: [17 & 23 Hill Street, New Canaan] appeals/does not support the OSFM approval Part II Section (3) 503.1.2 and 01.233 "If agreeable to the owner/applicant & schedule allows. A site visit would be prudent". OSFM approved modification. Local Fire Marshal requested an appeal of the State Fire Marshal's decision. Counsel will look further into the jurisdiction of the appeal statute. Counsel requested to hold until next meeting. DAS Counsel is still working on this appeal. Hold on agenda.
- j) A-23-05 RE: Request for Appeal received 4/5/23 from David Taylor RE: [111 Founders Pl/323 Pitkin Street, East Hartford, CT] 2022 CSFSC Part IV 39.4.2.1. Appellant is asking the C&S Committee to review the compliance plan submitted to the East Hartford Fire Marshal (John Pelow) and reverse his decision to reject this plan. A motion to refer to the OSFM (KF), seconded by (MS). All in favor, none opposed. OSFM is working with Counsel to determine if they have jurisdiction. Hold on agenda for 30 days. One 6/12/23 Appellant withdrew appeal. Remove from agenda.
