 - Firefox is the recommended browser for this course. Additionally, Adobe Flash Player is required to use the features of this course. If you do not have these services downloaded on your computer, please see instructions included at the end of this packet.
- **Turn Off Pop-up Blocker:**
 - You will need to turn off your pop-up blocker or set it to allow pop-ups from <http://training.gaincc.org> in order to complete the lessons.
- **Course Contains Audio:**
 - Please turn up your speakers or plug in your headphones prior to beginning the course.

STEP-BY-STEP Process

1. Step One: Click Link and Login

- Using Firefox, go to: <http://training.gaincc.org>. You'll see the screen below:

2. Step Two: Access Course (Left Navigation Menu)

- In the Left Navigation Menu, click on “My Courses.”
- From here, a list of your courses will appear underneath “My Courses” in the navigation menu. Click on “**GAIN-Q3 Site Training Course**”

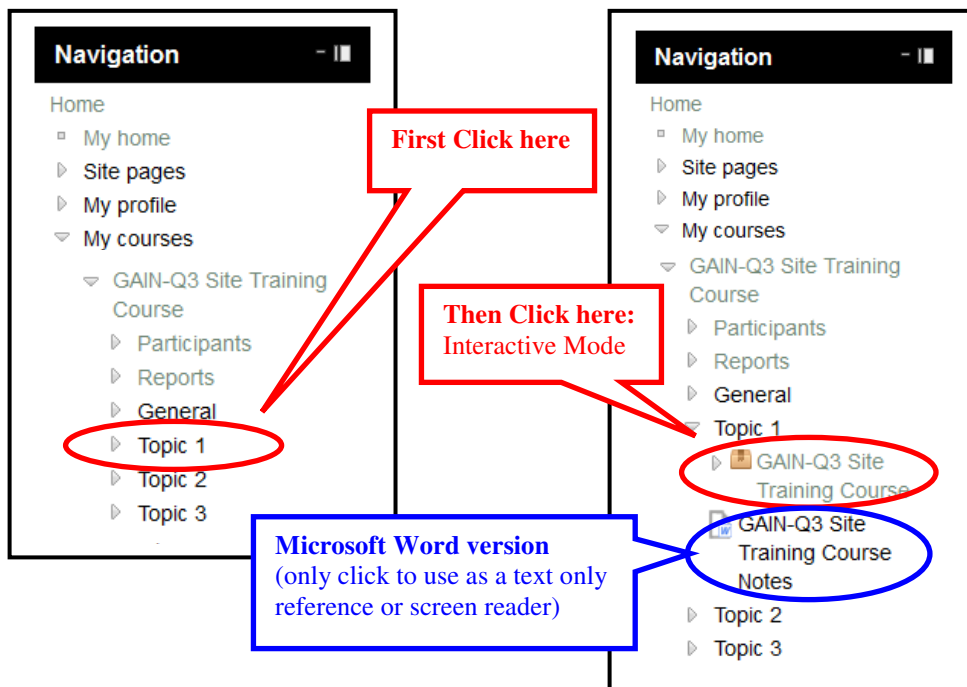


3. Step Three: Welcome Page for Course

4. Step Four: Click “Topic 1” then open Lesson 1

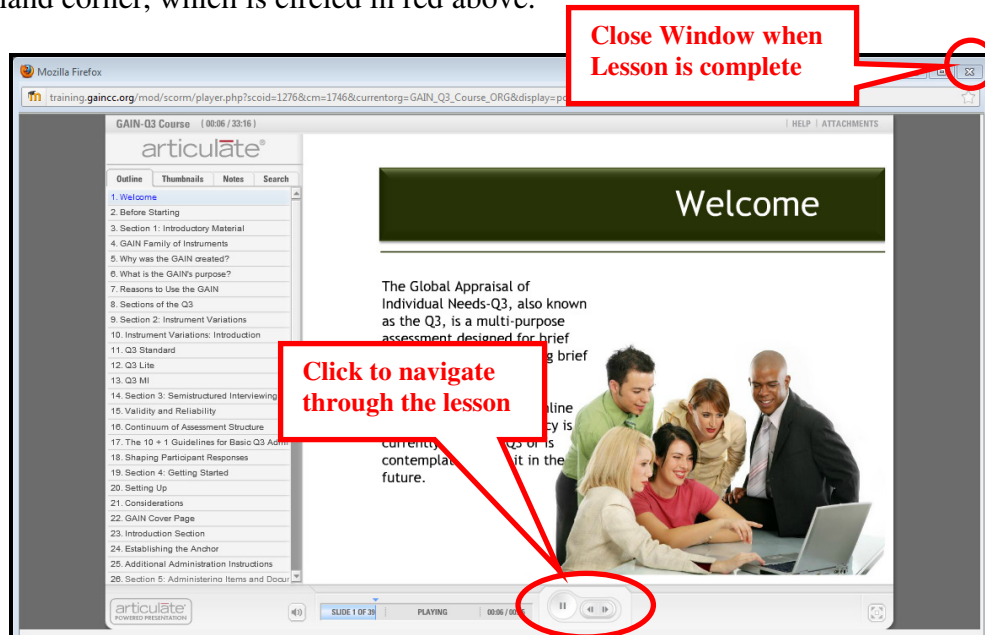
- To access the first lesson, click on Topic 1 in the Left Navigation Menu.
- From here, click on the link next to the brown file folders (See Lesson 1 circled in red below). The second link in each lesson is a Microsoft Word version of the lesson content that you can download as a reference or use with a screen reader.



5. Step Five: Click Enter

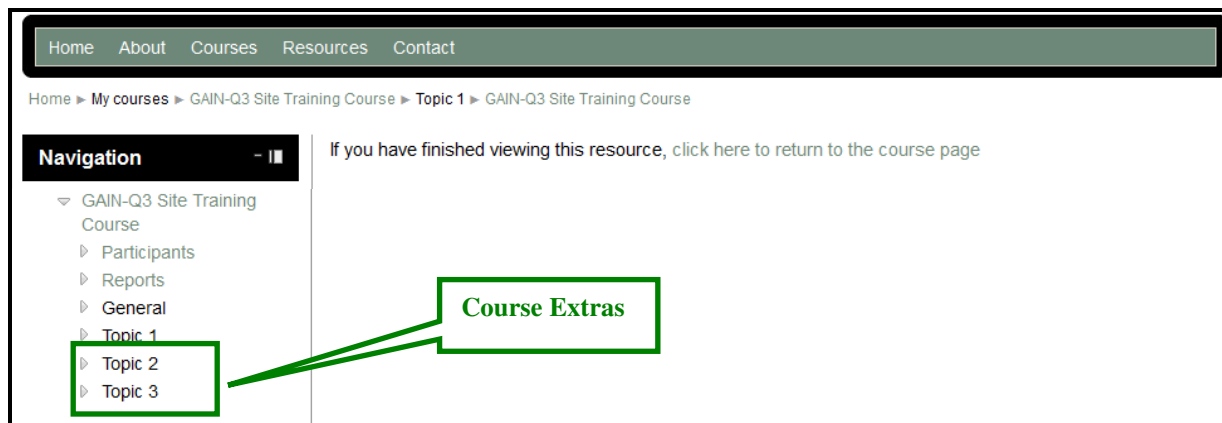
6. Step Six: Navigating Lesson

- Entering the lesson will open a new window
- The ◀ ▶ buttons can be used to move forward and backward within the lesson. You can also click on the slide titles in the outline on the left-hand side of the window.
 - **Note:** Some slides contain buttons within the slide with extra information. Be sure to view all content before moving to the next slide.
- When you have completed Lesson 1, close the lesson window by clicking on the X in the upper right-hand corner, which is circled in red above.



7. Step Seven: Course Extras

- Once you have closed out of Topic 1, you will be taken to the screen below. In the Left Navigation Menu, click Topics 2 and 3 for extra topics.

- **Topic 3 (Course Evaluation):** Your responses are confidential and will be used to improve our online coursework.

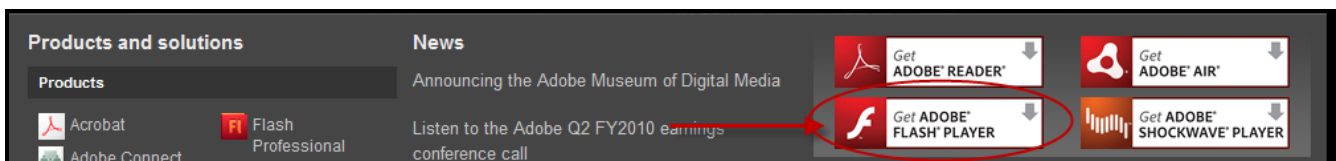
