Legal Matters

Case Number: 2023-729 Walgreens #02410; PCY.0001395

Attorney Michael Ando presented this case.

Respondent is a Connecticut Pharmacy investigated following their failure to remain open for the required 35 hours per week, failure to comply with unscheduled pharmacy closing requirements by being closed more than one calendar day for any one such closing, and for being closed more than twice in a thirty-day period. A total of 12 unscheduled pharmacy closings took place between May 11, 2022, and December 28, 2022.

Proposed Resolution:

Counsel for Drug Control proposes a settlement in which Respondent shall pay a voluntary monetary payment amount of \$2,000.00, which has been paid.

Commission Action: Commissioner Carbray moved, seconded by Commissioner DeFazio and passed by a vote of 5-0 to accept and approve the aforementioned settlement agreement.
