## Discussion/New Business

- 1. Low sulfur and bio blending questions. Concerns were expressed on charges related to Public Act 10-74 and the specific scope of authority for the board. Specifically in the implementation of the act with respect to biodiesel/bioheat and the low sulfur requirements there seemed to be a lack of clarity on whether these requirements were independent or linked in terms of implementation. Frank Greene will look into getting this clarified.
- 2. Name plate capacity. What mechanisms exist to determine the accurate production locations and capacity of biodiesel/bioheat manufactures/distributors? Are there existing reporting requirements?
