1. Proposed Well Drilling and Geothermal Systems Regulations

Julianne Avallone, Legal Division Director, sent the following update via email prior to the meeting:

The regulations have been approved by the Office of Policy And Management and are now pending review by the Governor's Counsel's Office.

2. Application Review Working Group

An Application Review Working Group has been established. The Board has determined that all applications except for those with a Connecticut Department of Labor letter of apprenticeship completion will come before this group.

Richard Hurlburt reported that the first meeting took place on October 7, 2020. Three applications were reviewed. One was approved and two will require additional documention to make a determination.

3. Contractors not registering workers as apprentices

At the February 6, 2020 meeting, discussion took place regarding the widespread issue of employees that are required to be registered as an apprentice upon hire not being registered by the contractor and possible solutions to the issue.

Discussion took place on this topic and the Board agreed that this remains an ongoing issue that they would like to address with DCP staff. The Board requested that Pamela

Brown, Director of Investigations, attend the November 5, 2020 meeting for further discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discussion on online continuing education classes and extension of due date for completing classes for the 2020 cycle.

General discussion took place regarding online classes that are taking place at this time. Classes seem to be going smoothly and no major problems were reported.

2. Discussion of an extension of time to take on-line continuing education offerings going into the 2021 cycle.
