General Requirements for Land Surveyor Classes 5, 6, 7 and 8 20-300-3(b)(5)

- (A) Maximum of one year of experience claimed per calendar year.
- (B) For part-time work, a maximum of 50% can be claimed.
- (C) Military work not necessarily equivalent.
- (D) Comingled experience (i.e. PE/LS) must be documented accordingly.
- (E) Name and number of supervising LS.

General Requirements for Land Surveyor in Training Classes 12, 13, 14 and 14A 20-300-3(d)(5)

- (A) Class 12 only, senior students in last semester of an approved curriculum (4 yr. Surveying), certificate issued only after graduation and passage of examination.
- (B) Experience claimed under classes 13, 14, and 14A shall be under the direct supervision of a licensed land surveyor.

Author's Note: The term 'land surveying' when applied to an applicant's experience record has been interpreted by the board as land boundary surveying, and does not include other surveying activities such as construction or engineering surveying, geodetic surveying, etc.
