Attorney Sosensky appeared before the Board today and expanded on his inquiries concerning sheet metal work in CT. DCP Commissioner Jerry Farrell, Jr. has responded to Attorney Sosensky's inquiries via his letter dated January 18, 2008. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC PRESENT

Todd Rose expressed concern regarding mechanical general contractors installing heating and air conditioning units and using them as a temporary source of heating and/or cooling before the construction job is done, which in effect, voids the manufacturer's warranty on the heating and/or cooling units. The Board informed Mr. Rose that he would have to contact the state building official or lobby the legislature concerning any code and/or statutory changes.
