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Chairperson Brandon called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes from the May 20, 2013 meeting were reviewed. Chairperson Brandon made a motion to accept the minutes, Patricia Masi seconded, and all were in favor.

COMMENTS OR CONCERNS OF ANY PERSON PRESENT TODAY

Chairperson Brandon received a call for an extension of time to get required CEU points. He did not recall this Board ever receiving this type of request. He shared with the Board an email received from Sabina Lohr whose Registered Professional Reporter designation through the NCRA had lapsed.

After a brief discussion regarding one's Licensed Shorthand Reporter designation in Connecticut and an RPR status through NCRA, the Board decided to deny Ms. Lohr the extension. The Board felt it does not have the personnel nor any procedure in place to monitor reporters who are "on extension".

Chairperson Brandon will send Ms. Lohr a letter denying her the additional time along with the reasoning for such decision. The letter will also outline some suggestions for Ms. Lohr to secure CEUs through NCRA.

APPLICATIONS

The Board received two new applications for review and acceptance.
