Connecticut Coalition for Sustainable Materials Management,

Trilogy Financial Group would like to assist in helping you come up with a cost-effective system to get close to zero waste. We held a zoom conference with DEEP in February 2020 (see Zoom link below) to describe our system. We believe multiple sorting sites should be constructed throughout Connecticut to reduce transportation cost and traffic. Each location would sort the metals, plastic, organics and glass with the metals being sold to the market. Organic materials, cardboard, paper, wood and green waste would be fed to an anaerobic digester that would create renewable pipeline gas. The glass would be picked up for recycling and the plastics would be gasified and turned into a fuel blend and sold to the marketplace. These plants would be designed, constructed and financed by Trilogy at no cost to the state or municipalities. The sale of the products (gas and oil) along with the tipping fees would be used to pay for the facilities, the only requirement would be to commit to a long-term trash supply contract at the current tipping fee pricing.
