- New Eligibility Applications (EAs) for projects needing funding during SFY 2021 (July 1,2020 – June 30, 2021) have been completed and the Project Priority List is being prepared.
- The public hearing on the SFY 2021 DWSRF Intended Use Plan and Project Priority List will be held in a virtual setting and an announcement will be published with a 30 day public comment period prior to the hearing
- No new news on the status of the anticipated federal stimulus bill for infrastructure, including drinking water but details will be provided once available and a specific request for eligible infrastructure projects will be issued at the appropriate time

Remote Sanitary Surveys

- DWS developed a five page remote sanitary survey template *First page completed by DWS
 - Last four pages completed by certified operators including pictures of critical components
 - Submit completed document to DWS within two weeks
 Follow up as necessary by DWS and issue sanitary survey report
- Start pilot program this week with 26 small water systems and 10 certified operators, DWS will be looking for feedback
- Roll out to rest of small PWSs late June
- Working separately on template for larger PWSs, plan similar pilot program with larger PWSs sometime in late June






Tracking per State Drought Plan



- Statewide Percent full is 97.96% Statewide Percent of Normal is 102%
- 18 Reservoir Systems are reporting 100% Full (-5 from previous week, 16 trending
- 31 Systems are still reporting capacities greater than or equal to 100% of Normal
- Current Conditions: US Drought Monitor has northern portion of CT in D0 abnormally dry



Stream flows also indicate drying conditions. June Precip outlook looks dryer.
