DPH/DWS Updates – Reopening

- Phase 3 Reopen Rules (mid-July)
- ** Note: additional information regarding Phase 3 will be coming soon **
 - * Restaurants, Breweries & Wineries
 - **Rules for Gatherings and Venues (additional guidance in Phase 2 below)**
 - ✓ Indoor private gatherings 50 people
 - ✓ Outdoor private gatherings (including Graduations) 250 people
 - ✓ Outdoor organized gatherings (e.g. Fireworks, Concert in Municipal Park) 15 feet of space blanket to blanket, no cap. Event organizer responsible for compliance with guidance.
 - ✓ Outdoor Event Venues (e.g. Amphitheaters, Race Tracks) 50% of Fire Capacity and distancing

DPH/DWS Updates – Reopening

- Hot dry days coupled with reopening presenting us with unprecedented water demands causing water discoloration or insufficient pressure
- Conditions ripe for bacterial contamination and legionella growth
- Communicate often with customers and draft measures to be followed especially by HCFs
- Obviously report these events to DPH/DWS promptly
- Alternative care sites and shelters- Continue to provide technical assistance
- DWS "Return To Service" guidance is on DWS webpage

Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

- New Eligibility Applications (EAs) for projects needing funding during SFY 2021 (July 1,2020 June 30, 2021) have been completed and the Project Priority List is being prepared.
- The public hearing on the SFY 2021 DWSRF Intended Use Plan and Project Priority List will be held in a virtual setting and an announcement will be published with a 30 day public comment period prior to the hearing
- No new news on the status of the anticipated federal stimulus bill for infrastructure, including drinking water but details will be provided if and when available and a specific request for eligible infrastructure projects will be issued at the appropriate time



Tracking per State Drought Plan




- 5 Reservoir Systems are reporting 100% Full (-13 from 2 weeks ago, 29 trending 👢)
- 23 Systems are still reporting capacities greater than or equal to 100% of Normal, 31 2wk ago
- Current Conditions: US Drought Monitor has large portions of CT in D0 abnormally dry



Stream flows also indicate very dry conditions.
July precipitation outlook

July precipitation outlook is equal chance.

- DWS developed a five page remote sanitary survey template
- Started pilot program with 26 small water systems and 10 certified operators, DWS will be looking for feedback to finalize the process and template
- Roll out to rest of small PWSs in early July
- Working separately on template for larger PWSs. Will share with P3 for input and roll out in mid July
