### **Contaminants and Drinking Water Quality**

- UCMR5-Proposed
  - 29 PFAS chemicals plus lithium
  - Will expand to include systems 3,300-10,000 pending appropriation to EPA
  - Comment period open through May 10, 2021
- PFAS
  - DPH and DEEP continue work toward implementing the recommendations in the PFAS Action Plan

- CL 2021-25 2021 MDL Guidance
  - Always check the approved method for reference to the MDL and if it is applicable.
  - If the method references 40 CFR part 136 Appendix B, the new MDL procedure must be used.
  - If the method itself has an MDL procedure listed that procedure can be followed or the new MDL procedure can be used.
  - Pooling of data from multiple instruments is not allowed for drinking water methods. EPA Laboratory Drinking Water Certification Manual Chapter IV, Sect. 7.2.9 (Initial Demonstration of Capability) IDC, which includes MDLs, states that IDCs must be performed on each instrument that analyzes compliance samples.







- DPH received 32 applications for \$112M in DWSRF funding for SFY 2022 by the March 31, 2021 deadline
- DPH received an additional 11 applications for \$104M in DWSRF funding for lead service line inventory and/or replacement projects by the April 16, 2021 deadline
- The Biden Administration's American Jobs Plan is proposed to include \$45 billion in funding for lead service line replacements and \$56 billion for aging infrastructure
