- 3. March minutes are accepted.

State Update

- Dermot distributed a <u>preliminary</u> draft of ETPH criteria. The reporting limit for ETPH is expected to change from a concentration of 100 ug/L to 250 ug/L which is more reasonable. The reporting limit and the action limit will be the same. The ELCP group is anticipating a letter from DEEP which will announce the change.
- 2. EPH and VPH limits are postponed for the RSRs.
- 3. Dermot's circular letter with correct storm water analysis regulation information is posted on the EPOC website.
- 4. In the pending RSR update, a partial or full 2008 list may be used. A purpose of the update is to get ETPH criteria into regulations.
- Radon Collection Preliminary draft can be found in the "New England States' Common Sample Collection & Preservation Manual for Drinking Water". Current procedure was written by the radon program and was edited by ELCP. When complete, entire document will be sent to the labs.
- 6. An email was sent to the laboratories with a link to the Federal Register's most resent Methods Update Rule from April 17th. Kim will send downloaded MURII files to Barbara, Peter and Kathy.
