- 2. Dermot PT for EPH/VPH is the same PT for ETPH, just doing a different method.
- 3. Bob Will send out to committee members a two page summary of the updated Total Coliform Rule.
- 4. Dermot Regarding microbiological sampling for drinking water, the New England Sampling procedure is straight forward. Flaming and alcohol is not advised and is not in the procedure.
- 5. Kim Is there an expiration date for trip blanks? Dermot will follow up.

- 7. Health Department Certification will not be asking for drinking water MDLs any longer. Dermot will tailor a letter for circulation to all labs.
