The contract between Junta for Progressive Action, Inc. . (the Contractor) and the Department of Social Services (the Department), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Office of the Attorney General on 10/21/15 , is hereby further amended as follows:

1. The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$95,417 from \$295,370 to \$390,787. The additional funds are to allow Contractor to continue services for an additional 9 months.
2. The budget on page 2 of Amendment 1 shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the budget of page 2 of this amendment.
3. The term of this contract shall be extended by 9 months and the end date of the contract is changed from 9/30/16 to 6/30/17.
4. DSS contact/contract person on page 1 of the original contract shall be deleted and replaced as follows: Donna LoCurto at (860) 424-5323.

All terms and conditions of the original Contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.




