



# ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY COUNCIL 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION UPDATE

### **GOVERNORS BILLS IMPACTING SUBSTANCE USE**

SB-888 REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO JOINT RULE 9. 'AN ACT RESPONSIBLY AND EQUITABLY REGULATING ADULT-USE CANNABIS', to implement the Governor's budget recommendations. (related: HB-6377, HB-5313)

<u>HB -6439</u> REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO JOINT RULE 9. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2023, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR', to implement the Governor's budget recommendations.

<u>HB-6450</u> REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO JOINT RULE 9. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING PUBLIC HEALTH', to implement the Governor's budget recommendations. (related: SB-326, HB-5582, SB-40, SB-41, SB-44, SB-113, SB-115)

#### Law Enforcement/Judicial:

<u>HB-5195</u> ACT CREATING A THREE STRIKES POLICY FOR RESIDENTIAL RENTERS AND OWNERS UPON WHOSE PROPERTY OPIOID OVERDOSES HAVE OCCURRED

<u>HB-5162</u> AN ACT CREATING A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE, THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION S ERVICES AND MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES REGARDING CARE OF PEOPLE ADDICTED TO OPIOIDS

<u>HB-5141</u> AN ACT PERMITTING FAMILY MEMBERS TO PETITION FOR MANDATORY ASSESSMENT AND TREATMENT OF CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ABUSING DRUGS OR ALCOHOL

HB-5723 AN ACT CONCERNING POLICE DEPARTMENT ACCESS TO OPIOID ANTAGONISTS SUCH AS NARCAN.

<u>HB-5078</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF TECHNOLOGY THAT POLICE OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL MAY USE WHEN RESPONDING TO OPIOID OVERDOSES.

HB-5162 AN ACT CREATING A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE, THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES AND MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES REGARDING CARE OF PEOPLE ADDICTED TO OPIOIDS.

<u>HB-5586</u> AN ACT REQUIRING EXPANSION OF THE CRISIS INITIATIVE PILOT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

HB-5935 AN ACT CONCERNING CLEAN SLATE AND AUTOMATIC ERASURE OF CRIMINAL

<u>HB-5992</u> AN ACT REQUIRING TRANSPORTATION TO A TREATMENT FACILITY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL TRIAGE OR TO A HOSPITAL AFTER ADMINISTRATION OF AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST.

HB-6249 AN ACT CONCERNING TELEHEALTH.

HB-5068 AN ACT CONCERNING RECOVERY NAVIGATORS AND THEIR ROLE IN ADDRESSING THE

HB-5406 AN ACT CONCERNING THE TREATMENT OF CHRONIC PAIN WITHOUT OPIOID DRUGS.

<u>HB-5407</u> AN ACT REQUIRING THE DISPENSING AND ADMINISTERING OF METHADONE TO BE REPORTED THROUGH THE ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING PROGRAM.

HB-5550 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE CONCERNING PEER SUPPORT SPECIALISTS

SB-659 AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN OPIOID RECOVERY AND REFORM PILOT PROGRAM.

HB-6117 AN ACT CONCERNING A TAX CREDIT FOR BUSINESSES THAT HIRE INDIVIDUALS IN RECOVERY FROM SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS.
