PA 21-28 requires:

 The council shall submit the statewide policy and interagency approach and any other recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to transportation, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

Draft policy:

- Should be high level in first year to allow the council and subcommittees room to expand work
- Should follow proven Vision Zero strategies
- Should reflect the missions and duties of state agencies who sit on the council






