
Birth Facility Flow Chart for: Newborn Hearing Screening (NBHS) and congenital Cytomegalovirus (CMV) Testing*



- PCP: ASAP.
- Parent/Guardian: in writing.
- Also, give Parent a copy of Your Baby Needs a CMV Test and a Hearing Test.
- Optional Give parent a copy of the **Shared Plan of** Care (SPOC).
- EHDI: Enter results into Maven <u><</u> 3 business days.

Step 2: REFER FOR PEDIATRIC AUDIOLOGICAL EVALUATION

- Make audiology appointment for newborn before discharge.
- Enter appointment information into "Audiologist Referral" field in Maven. This is critical to our follow-up.
- See following page for audiology centers.

Goal: Audiological diagnosis by 3 months of age.

It is critical that you test prior to 21 days of age.

- Urine or saliva are currently acceptable.
 - Wait 1 to 2 hours after breastfeeding before taking saliva.
- Notify parents and PCP of results ASAP.
- Enter results into Maven < 3 business days.
- If no CMV test done:
 - Inform PCP\parent ASAP.
 - Note why in Maven.
- Document parent CMV refusal internally and note it in the Maven comments fields.

*New CMV legislation takes effect July 1, 2025, and will supersede this document.
