Effective October 26, 2023, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service's (FNS) Final Rule, Child Nutrition Programs: Community Eligibility Provision – Increasing Options for Schools, lowered the minimum ISP for CEP school eligibility from 40 percent to 25 percent. **Note: The final rule does not change the 1.6 multiplier for establishing CEP claiming percentages.**

**The data below may not be fully reflective of the number of identified students and are intended only for informational purposes. The data do not confer final school-level eligibility for participation in the CEP. LEAs are eligible to participate in the CEP if the ISP for the entire district, groups of schools, or individual**
