FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

Procedural History:

This matter is before the Hearing Officer pursuant to a request for a Due Process Hearing filed by the Parent on August 20, 2012. A Pre-hearing conference was scheduled for September 4, 2012 at 5:00 PM. At 4:04 PM, September 4, 2012, Counsel for the parent notified the hearing officer by email that he was withdrawing the complaint, with prejudice and that the pre-hearing conference was no longer needed.
