FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer Student an appropriate program for the 2012-2013 school year?
2. If not, should the Board be required to support a private placement for Student?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/ SUMMARY:

The Parent initiated a Request for Due Process Hearing on September 9, 2012. The original mailing date of the final decision was November 20, 2012. A prehearing conference was held on October 4, 2012 and a hearing scheduled for November 15, 2012. On November 1, 2012, the Parent's attorney informed the Hearing Officer that the parties had executed a Settlement Agreement of the dispute and that the Parent was withdrawing the Due Process Request with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
