# FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board fail to provide FAPE for the two years prior to filing the complaint?
- 2. Did the Board fail to implement Student's IEP?
- 3. Did the Board fail to evaluate Student in all areas of suspected disability?
- 4. If any of 1-3 is in the negative, do the circumstances warrant two years of compensatory education for Student beyond the 2018-2019 school year?
- 5. If any of 1-3 is in the negative, does the Student require an out of district placement?
- 6. If any of 1-3 is in the negative, does the Student require an independent communication evaluation?
- 7. If any of 1-3 is in the negative, does the Student require an independent transition evaluation?

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on February 7, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on February 21, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on February 28, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for April 26, 2017. On April 24, 2017, the Parent withdrew the Hearing Request without prejudice

#### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
