ISSUES:

- 1. Does the Student require evaluation to determine whether he is a child with a disability under the IDEA?
- 2. If so, should the Parents be ordered to make the Student available for evaluation?

The Board filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on February 24, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on and conducted a Prehearing Conference on February 24, 2017.
