# FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board fail to promptly identify Student as a student with disability?
- 2. Did the Board provide an appropriate program for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 school years and extended school years?
- 3. If not, do the circumstances warrant an award of compensatory education?
- 4. If not, should Parents be reimbursed for all tuition and education related expenses for the student?

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on June 9, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on June 12, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on June 20, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for August 18, 2017. On the day of the hearing, the Parent's attorney reported that the parties had settled the dispute and that the Parent was withdrawing the Due Process Complaint without prejudice.

## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
