From 2003 to 2008, Gallahue was a staff reporter for The New York Post, where he wrote about crime, development, politics and transit. In 2008, he shared honors on a first place award from the Deadline Club.

He holds a B.A. from Long Island University, Brooklyn Campus, and an LL.M. in International Human Rights Law from the National University of Ireland, Galway.
