ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION IS CLOSED – STILL TIME TO REGISTER IN PERSON

HARTFORD: Connecticut Secretary of the State Denise Merrill has announced that online voter registration closed at midnight but there is still time to register in person for the April 26 primary.

The deadline for in-person registration for new and unaffiliated voters in order to participate in the presidential preference primary is noon on April 25. Eligible voters can register with the town clerk or registrars at town hall.

There is **NO ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION FOR THE PRIMARY**.

Only complete absentee ballots received before the close of polls on the day of the primary will be counted, barring a medical emergency.
