Subject: Hazardous Duty Retirement for Certain Judicial Branch Employees
Excluded from Collective Bargaining

Date: July 1, 1999

In accordance with Connecticut General Statutes 5-200(p), the Commissioner of the Department of Administrative Services, with the approval of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, approves employees in certain Judicial Branch job classifications excluded from Collective Bargaining as eligible for Hazardous Duty Retirement under the State Employees Retirement Act. Employees in these classifications regularly perform the full range of investigative and law enforcement duties that their subordinate employees, who are covered by the hazardous duty provisions, perform. Therefore, **effective July 1, 1999** incumbents in the following Judicial Branch job classifications are eligible for Hazardous Duty Retirement:

Chief Judicial Marshal I
Chief Judicial Marshal II
Deputy Chief Judicial Marshal
