### *Directions to Lockwood Farm*

FROM WILBUR CROSS PARKWAY (ROUTE 15) TRAVELING NORTH: Take Exit 61, Whitney Avenue. Turn right off the exit and go north for 2.3 miles. Turn left onto Evergreen Avenue at the traffic light, go 0.1 mile and turn right onto Kenwood Avenue. The farm is on the left; enter the second driveway. TRAVELING SOUTH: Take Exit 62, Whitney Avenue. Turn right off the exit and go north for 2.2 miles. Turn left onto Evergreen Avenue at the traffic light, go 0.1 mile and turn right onto Kenwood Avenue. The farm is on the left; enter the second driveway.

FROM INTERSTATE 91 TRAVELING NORTH: Take Exit 10. Follow the Route 40 connector for 3.1 miles. Turn right onto Whitney Avenue (Route 10) and go north for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Evergreen Avenue at the traffic light, go 0.1 mile and turn right onto Kenwood Avenue. The farm is on the left; enter the second driveway. TRAVELING SOUTH: Take Exit 10. Follow the Route 40 connector for 3.0 miles. Turn right onto Whitney Avenue (Route 10) and go north for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Evergreen Avenue at the traffic light, go 0.1 mile and turn right onto Kenwood Avenue. The farm is on the left; enter the second driveway.
