## A Strategic Approach to Addressing Health Equity for those at for Risk for Diabetes

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) or the Department, Diabetes Prevention and Management Program announces the availability of fiscal year 2024 funds. The following are major categories of activities to be supported through this Request for Proposal:

**Component A**: Two Health care organizations to implement evidence-based diabetes prevention and management programs.

**Component B:** Technical Assistance contractor to assist health care organizations implementing diabetes prevention and management programs and to increase access statewide to CDC-recognized diabetes prevention life-style change programs.

Proposals must identify the Components addressed from the list above, provide a description of the strategies planned to address the public health concern, identify the target population and how the program addresses their needs including health equity, and identify the outcome objectives each program will work towards achieving.

This request for proposal is a total of up to \$150,000 a year for component A and \$75,000 a year for Component B. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) are available to support these services. Funding will be for a 4.5 year period beginning approximately January April 1, 2024, through June 30, 2028, subject to the availability of funds and satisfactory program performance.
