## **UNREGISTERED PERSONS, FIRMS AND PRODUCTS**



A person or firm is unregistered and not legally able to provide services. Always check if a person, firm or product is registered before doing business with them.

#### **INVESTMENT PROPERTY SCHEMES**



"Investment opportunities" promising high returns and low to no risk.

#### **PONZI SCHEMES**



Early investors paid with money raised from later investors. No underlying business or product.

## PRIVATE PLACEMENTS



Offerings of unregistered securities to a limited pool of investors.

#### **PROMISSORY NOTE SCHEMES**



Promissory notes are a form of a loan or IOU. Promise investors a fixed return.

### **COMMODITY INVESTMENTS - CRYPTOCURRENCY**



Social media and/or offshore websites offering ways to invest in cryptocurrencies which may not be legitimate.
