




Individual Income Tax Instructions - (CT-1040 or CT-1040NR/PY)

myconneCT is a free to use online application to file your individual income tax returns that helps taxpayers prevent math errors and calculates fields for them. Please go to portal.ct.gov/drs to see "What's New" and refer to the Individual Income Tax instruction booklet for more detailed instructions.

Please be prepared to submit any of the following forms as attachments. If applicable, you must include them in your filing:

- . Form CT-1040CRC, Claim of Right Credit
- Form CT-19IT, Title 19 Status Release
- Form 1310, Refund Due for a Deceased Taxpayer
- Form CT-8379, Nonobligated Spouse Claim
- Form CT-2210, Underpayment of Estimated Income Tax by Individuals, Trusts, and Estates
- Other (e.g., copy of your federal return, other jurisdiction etc.)

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
If you have an overpayment and have not selected any of the contribution options in the previous step, you will be prompted to select either Check or Direct Deposit for your refund method.






In this example we have selected Direct Deposit.

Include applicable supporting documentation with your filing. To include attachments, click Add.















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Select the file you wish to attach, provide a description of the document, then click **OK**. Repeat these steps until all necessary supporting documentation has been added to the filing.
