









Select the desired payment option and click Next.

The payment withdrawal from your bank may take **up to five (5) business days**. Once the payment has been processed from your bank, the original payment date will be honored.

Use this request to make an estimated payment towards a filing period.

Enter the payment amount, then confirm the payment amount and date. Select the payment type. Most will select *Direct Payment*.

Taxpayers who report on other than a calendar year basis should use their federal estimated tax installment due dates. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, your estimated payment will be considered timely if filed on the next business day.



If this is the first payment using this bank account through **myconneCT**, an account validation will be sent to the bank. The payment withdrawal from your bank may take **up to five (5) business days.** Once the payment has been processed from your bank, the original payment date will be honored.

Due dates of installments and the amount of required payments for 2023 calendar year taxpayers are:

- . April 17, 2023 A total of 25% of your required annual payment should be paid by this date
- June 15, 2023 A total of 50% of your required annual payment should be paid by this date
- September 15, 2023 A total of 75% of your required annual payment should be paid by this date
- . January 16, 2024 A total of 100% of your required annual payment should be paid by this date

Taxpayers who report on other than a calendar year basis should use their federal estimated tax installment due dates. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, your estimated payment will be considered timely if filed on the next business day.




