Have you ever wondered how many students are reading on grade level in your child's school, how your district's graduation rate compares to the rest of the state, or how many high school graduates enroll in and graduate from college? EdSight, Connecticut's education data portal, can answer these questions and more for every public school and district in Connecticut.

Join us for an interactive workshop to learn about the information available in EdSight and how to navigate the system.

- This workshop will guide you through tools that show overall school and district performance, like the Connecticut Report Cards and the Next Generation Accountability Index.
- You will be able to drill down on topics like enrollment, student performance, discipline, chronic absence, and graduation rates.
- You will also learn how to find information for specific student groups, such as English language learners or students with disabilities.
- With new tools in EdSight, we will explore the impact of the pandemic on student achievement.

Who Should Attend: This session is open to all parents and families interested in school and district performance data. It will be particularly informative for members of boards of education, school governance councils, PTAs, PTOs, SEPTAs, and staff working with parent leaders.

Equipment: Using a computer or tablet (rather than a phone) is recommended for this workshop.
