Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2015 Regular Session on June 23<sup>rd</sup>.

- SB 913      AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENROLLMENT OF NON-STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES IN  
PA 15-93      THE STATE EMPLOYEE HEALTH PLAN.

This bill shall take effect July 1, 2015.
