EXECUTIVE ORDER 32


**WHEREAS**, the Governor issued Executive Order 30 in response to dangerous travel conditions that resulted from high winds and heavy snowfall on February 8 and February 9, 2013;

**WHEREAS**, current conditions no longer require modification of regulatory requirements related to the specifications of vehicles used by emergency medical service providers in the transport of patients;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Dannel P. Malloy, Governor of the State of Connecticut, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby **RESCIND** the remaining part of Executive Order 30 that remains in effect modifying section 19a-179-18 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
