- HB 5591 AN ACT CONCERNING THE MACHINERY RENTAL SURCHARGE RATE,
PA 18-136 CERTAIN MUNICIPAL FILING FEES AND THE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION
FOR CERTAIN PAINT MIXING MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 302 AN ACT CONCERNING TELEHEALTH SERVICES.
PA 18-148 This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 303 AN ACT CONCERNING OUTPATIENT CLINICS, URGENT CARE CENTERS AND
PA 18-149 FREESTANDING EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- SB 304 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MATERNAL MORTALITY REVIEW PROGRAM AND
PA 18-150 COMMITTEE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- SB 377 AN ACT AUTHORIZING AGENCY CAPTIVE INSURANCE COMPANIES.
PA 18-151 This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- HB 5208 AN ACT CONCERNING MAMMOGRAMS, BREAST ULTRASOUNDS AND
PA 18-159 MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING OF BREASTS.
This bill takes effect January 1, 2019.

HB 5149 AN ACT CONCERNING SOBER LIVING HOMES.
PA 18-171 This bill is effective October 1, 2018.

SB 198 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY METHODS OF
SA 18-21 DEVELOPING, EXPANDING AND IMPROVING THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY
WORKFORCE IN THIS STATE.

As of this date, the Governor has signed one hundred and sixty-three (163) bills, vetoed four (4) bills, and left unsigned one (1) bill of the 2018 Regular Session.
