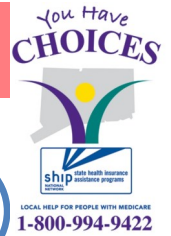

The State may be able to buy Medicare Part A & B for you
Enroll "conditionally" in Medicare A & enroll in B through Social Security 1-800-772-1213 or enroll online:
www.ssa.gov/medicare/apply.html
Benefits will begin the month CT pays for your Medicare A & B premiums.

Call Access Health CT Benefits Center at 1-855-805-4325 14 days before your 65th birthday
Cancel your qualified health plan for the day before your Medicare effective date

Enroll in the Medicare Savings Program with proof of your Medicare enrollment online:
www.connect.ct.gov, in person at any Department of Social Services office or call CHOICES 1-800-994-9422

Consider enrollment in a Medicare Supplement plan if you have not elected a Medicare Advantage Plan
