17 short leaved chestnuts averaging 20 ft. x 6-8 in.
Some dead branches probably due to natural pruning.
Trees are on lawn sod.

3. long leaved chestnuts very healthy - 25-30 ft. 10-12 in.
Necessary to see Mr. Speed to find this place.
- Strong.

Castanea sp.

John Barr McFarren, Cherokee Park, East Louisville, Ky.
This is the second planting to which Mr. Speed (g.v.)
directed me. Located on Cherokee Drive, on country
place. 8 trees in fine condition, long leaved, 35 ft x
24 in. DBH. - Strong, June 1927.

Castanea sp.

Mr. Clancy, on Cherokee Drive, Cherokee Park, East
Louisville, Ky., the third place located for me
by Mr. Speed (g.v.) Trees on a country place across
drive from McFarren's (g.v.) Name may be McClancy.
7 trees not so healthy. Short leaved with many
dead branches in lower parts. I found many
orange colored stromata but these on close examination
with lens appeared to contain apothecia. Trees averaged
20 ft. x 6-8 in. DBH. 3 trees long leaved. - Strong.
