The Department of Plant Pathology and Ecology has a position opening for Seasonal Research Assistant. We are looking for motivated individuals with a willingness to work, learn and assist with the Plant Disease Information Office: Responsibilities include receiving and documenting plant samples submitted for diagnosis, logging entries into a database, assisting with general laboratory practices, and occasional field trips for plant sampling. Training is provided. In addition to the above, the position will involve working under Dr. Yonghao Li in the seed testing program that will involve preparing seed germination tests. Starting date is May 1, 2019 and will run until October 31, 2019, but have flexible start and end dates within this general timeframe.

The position is based at the Experiment Station's New Haven campus at 123 Huntington Street. The hours of work are 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., M-F (35 hr./wk.), and the salary is \$11.50/hr. (without benefits).
