SEASONAL RESEARCH ASSISTANT

The Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station anticipates an opening for a Seasonal Research Assistant position for immediate hire. The successful candidate will assist in laboratory studies investigating the association between mosquitoes and their microbiome. Principle duties include: maintenance of bacterial isolates, nucleic acid extraction, and basic bacterial genetics. Applicants with course work and lab experience in cell and molecular biology, biochemistry, and genetics is desirable. Training will be provided.

Positions are durational for up to six months after date of hire. The hours of work are 8:30-4:30, M-F (35 hr./wk.) and the starting salary is \$11.00/hr.
