A planting of approx. 40 trees, 40 yrs old. Size of nuts vary considerably. The owner sold 1000# nuts in 1932, & 1933 over 600#. Trees have suffered from winter injury. There were thousands of seedlings. No evidence of chest. blight.

300 yds east is a large old chinquapin 4 x 5 1/2 ft in diam. near ground, tree heavily laden. a large shpt. sent to Wash. D.C.
